The children at DOTAC Conference program will provide an opportunity for children (ages 8-12) to explore the theme of Respecting Covenant; Risking the Journey toward Reconciliation. The children and their leaders will explore and engage in the themes of the conference through hands-on activities, prayer, games, drama, storytelling and song. We will provide a safe and welcoming environment for children to connect with each other, their leaders and the theme.

The program will include trips to the Museum of Anthropology, UBC's Greenheart Treewalk and swimming at the UBC Aquatic Centre.



The children are encouraged to share in the larger Conference programming when they are not meeting with their leaders. This includes:

Wednesday – travel day and short evening program

Friday – UBC visits in the morning and ministry site visits in the afternoon with the evening free

Sunday – worship in local congregations and then, free until cultural event in the evening

Tuesday – breakfast and travel day

Registration for the children's program is part of the Conference registration form. Registration for this program will close May 1st.

The program is limited to 12, if we do not meet the minimum of 6, we will notify you by May 2nd if the program is canceled.
